WHEREAS, Resolution 15-4111 declared that certain parcels were not needed for City purposes and authorized a sealed bid process to effectuate the sale of such parcels; and

WHEREAS, said property is hereby located in Miami-Dade County, Florida and further described in Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the sealed bid process yielded an offer of \$3,326,000.00 from Dolph17, LLC; and

WHEREAS, based on the broad home rule powers granted to municipalities by Article VIII, Section 2(b), Florida Constitution, and implemented by Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, the "Municipal Home Rule Powers Act", municipalities shall have the governmental, corporate, and proprietary powers to enable them to conduct municipal government, perform municipal functions, and render municipal services, and may exercise any power for municipal purposes, except when expressly prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, City Commission has determined that it is the best interest of the City to sell the aforementioned parcels.
