PERMIT CHECKLIST AND CONDITIONS

1. Permit process:

- We are only accepting permits applications through email. No hard copies. Please print the permit application in this package and fill it out properly, legibly and send it to pwsubmittals@cityofsweetwater.fl.gov.
- Plans shall be digitally signed and sealed.
- Submit an upfront fee in the amount of \$100 payable to the City of Sweetwater. Payment can be made by check, cashier check, money order or credit card (credit card authorization form can be found at https://cityofsweetwater.fl.gov/engineering-division/). Checks payable to the City of Sweetwater Attn: Engineering Division 1701 NW 112 Ave #103 Sweetwater FL 33172.
- Once the application is processed the permit technician will email you a receipt for the charges. The permit number will be stated for your reference. **Use** assigned application number in subject line of email correspondences.
- Review comments, if any, will be emailed to the email addresses disclosed in the permit application.
- Permit fees will be sent to email addresses disclosed in the permit application.
- Payment of permit fees are satisfied.
- Permit issuance. Applicant/owner shall notify contractors information to pwsubmittals@cityofsweetwater.fl.gov.
- Contractor must be registered with the City of Sweetwater (registration information can be found at https://cityofsweetwater.fl.gov/building-and-zoning/
- An electronic copy of the approved permit application, approved plans and permit card will be emailed **only** to the email address disclosed in the permit application. All documentation must be updated annually.
 - NOTE: Permit applications that are in the approval process and dormant for 180 days will be deemed not active. Applicant will have to reapply.
- 2. A 24-hour notification shall be made when a site or job is ready for construction for which a permit has been granted. Contact the Engineering Division at 305-455-6585 or via email at pwsubmittals@cityofsweetwater.fl.gov. .
- 3. If a person pick up the permit and plans, he/she must be previously authorized by applicant/owner and present a government-issued photo ID, such as a driver's license, with picture and provide his/her contact information (phone and/or email address).
- 4. Plans/Profile sections and details, drawn to scale, with 11"X17" as minimum paper size.
- 5. For driveway permits, submit a signed and sealed property Survey less than 2 years old.
- 6. If vehicular and pedestrian traffic needs to be temporarily modified from its designed configuration, a Maintenance of traffic (MOT) is required.
- 7. If work is on public or private property submit copy of easement documents or written permission from owner.
- 8. Pre-construction meeting with the City Engineer may be requested. Call 305-455-6585, at least 72 hours in advance to schedule prior to start of construction.
- 9. **For Emergency work**, you mut notify before accessing the jobsite at 305-455-6585 or via email at pwsubmittals@cityofsweetwater.fl.gov. An after the fact permit shall be submitted to the Engineering Division within five working days after the work is complete.
- 10. <u>Hours of construction</u>: Standard time: 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, and 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday. No work shall be performed on Sundays or holidays without prior authorization from the City Administration, except for emergencies. If the Contractor deemed it necessary to work on Sundays and holidays, the Contractor must contact the Engineering Division at least 72 hours in advance.
- 11. Inspection are required at least one (1) business day before commencing of work, as well as, before proceeding to the next stage of installation or construction.

 To schedule an inspection call 305-4555-6585 or email at pwsubmittals@cityofsweetwater.fl.gov at least 24 hours in advance. Excavation, sub-base, lime rock base, form, pavement installation and final inspection (including form removal, sod and site cleanup) are required. A progress inspection may be required by the City at the end of every week for site safety maintenance and erosion and sediment control of job sites that are in progress. All Inspections must be approved, including the final inspection upon completion of the project in order to close the permit.
- 12. Failure to obtain an approved inspection within 180 calendar days will cause this permit to expire and additional fees levied. A permit becomes null and void if work or construction is not commenced within 180 days or is suspended or expires because of lack of progress or abandonment. The Contractor or permittee shall be responsible to keep track of the expiration date and status of their permit.
- 13. If work requires off duty police services, permit owner shall, whenever possible, use officers of the City of Sweetwater Police Department for said off-duty assignments. Approved MOT's which do not require an off duty police officer, may require one during emergencies or when other unexpected circumstances arise, and such requirement will be determined by the City of Sweetwater Police Department Use of non-Sweetwater law enforcement officers is authorized only on those occasions where the Sweetwater Police Department has been unable to provide services. (Ordinance 3589 Art1, 11-7-2011). Contact Police Department at (305) 552-9900 to request for traffic officer assistance.
- 14. Notification letters may be required to be delivered to area residents, as required by the City. Submit a copy of the notice to the Engineering Division for review prior to distribution.
- 15. Call Sunshine One Call at 1-800-432-4770 for locations before digging.
- 16. All construction areas must be kept clean, neat, and sanitary and be restored to original condition or better. Right-of-ways and neighboring properties shall be kept free from dirt and debris and must be protected from damage by equipment or vehicles.
- 17. Equipment and materials shall be stored within designated material & equipment storage area and shall not be stored on public right-of-ways.
- 18. Do not discharge water into right-of-ways or storm drains without prior approval or permits from DERM & City of Sweetwater Engineering Division.
- 19. Protect all stormwater catch basins from construction debris, sediments and potential pollutants using City approved Best Management Practices methods. FDEP CGP/NOI permits are required for projects disturbing more than 1 acre in land area.
- 20. Prevent creation of any obstructions or conditions that may become dangerous to the public.
- 21. Backfill and temporary asphalt patches must be installed adequately at the end of every workday unless otherwise authorized by the City.
- 22. Repair promptly any and all damages to public or private property caused by this exercise of the privileges granted under this authorization. Restoration shall be at least equal to the condition existing at the time of the damage or injury or as directed and approved by the City of Sweetwater Engineering Division.
- 23. This permit is issued pursuant to the City of Sweetwater Right-of-Way City Code. The City does not agree to any language found on the drawings, except as may be required by the Miami Dade County Building Code. This permit does not constitute approval or compliance with the rules, regulations, or requirements of any other jurisdiction, which may relate to the above project.
- 24. All work must be designed and constructed in accordance with the most current revision of the Miami-Dade County Public Works Manual, Parts 1 & 2, unless otherwise specified or directed by the City to conform to the City of Sweetwater Standard Specifications or FDOT Standard Specifications. All work requires a permit unless specifically exempted by the City.
